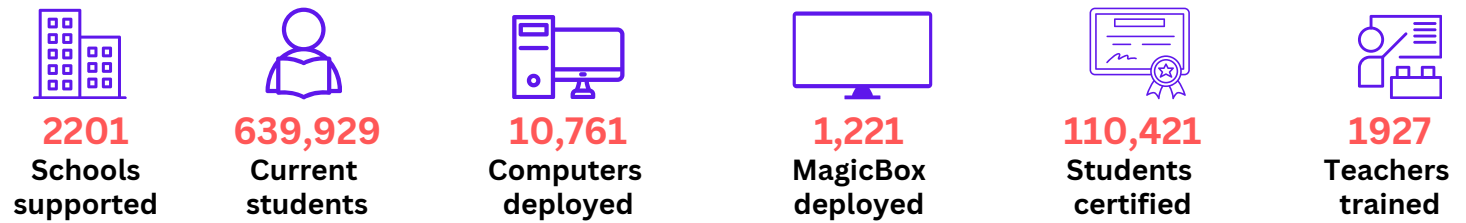
**Our Vision** is to bridge the divide between “haves” and “have-nots” using technology.

<b>Nature of the Organization</b>	Computer Shiksha is a charitable trust. It does not charge any fee for its services from anyone. The 'trustees' and 'patrons' are senior people from the industry and work pro bono.
<b>Current Footprint</b>	Schools enabled across all the 28 states of India. Working in 63 aspirational districts.
<b>Curriculum</b>	<p><b>Components of course -</b>  Learning uses &amp; parts of a computer, using paint to draw, file management, text processing &amp; formatting, using spreadsheets as databases and calculator, presentation skills, internet applications for browsing &amp; searching, e-mailing, uploading &amp; downloading files.  All learning is practical in nature. Each student works on a dedicated computer.</p>
<b>Duration of Course</b>	<p>1. Basic Course – 12 to 24 weeks, 2. Basic Plus Course – 19 to 38 weeks  3. Advanced Course – 24 to 48 weeks.  Assuming 2 classes per week. Schools are free to decide the pace of the course.</p>
<b>Delivery Model</b>	<p>We enable partner schools to conduct classes by</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enabling teachers with resources in the form of self-learning videos.
