2018 beginning has been a happy one. We started with 60 students six years back and we are approximately 12000 students now - that's a 200 times growth in 6 years. Obviously we may not be able to maintain this pace but the numbers will keep growing. We aim to reach 14000 students by April



2018 and to a million by April 2022. In a nutshell - we have miles to go before we sleep!

Paying it Forward Rakesh Suri, 55, Social Worker



With over 34 years of experience in the information Technology and management sectors, this CEO (IT Division) of a major testile firm, along with a few of his colleagues in 2012, set out to work towards delivering IT education to underprivileged schools.

"We first started with serving 60 slum children of a nearby school in Gurugram. But the effort spread so fast that we had 1,200 students of six schools within 14 months," says Rakesh Suri, the main force behind the initiative.

The Gurugiam-based NGO, Computer Shrisha, however, had its fair share of struggles as it hit the usual obstacles of resource, manpower and infrastructure crunch. "But I found a way to deliver the service by conquering all constraints," says Surt, an electronics engineer from BITS, Pilani and a PhO in Business Administration from Aligam Muslim University. "We shifted delivering computer education ourselves to enabling school partners to deliver the same and removed the human element," he explains. The number of total students trained through the institutive has risen to over 10,000. by Surth Sukanya Dutta

It is heartening for us to see that Computer Shiksha's growth has invited mainstream attention now.
